Critical Thinking & Argumentation

- Develop greater self-awareness when making judgments
- Learn about common pitfalls such as cognitive biases
- Get a deeper appreciation of different kinds of thought processes
- Sharpen skills in:
 - analysing and evaluating evidence and arguments
 - identifying assumptions
 - extracting the gist of information
 - making careful inferences from available information
 - developing your own arguments and anticipating objections
 - communicating arguments effectively.

Strategic Thinking & Problem Solving

- Focus on what it takes to 'see the Big Picture'
- Analyse complex situations to understand their dynamics and to see connections to other issues
- Identify opportunities for action and anticipate challenges
- See the possibilities - generate ideas or hypotheses, find solutions
- Assess different options to support sound decisions.

Typical workshops are for 12-16 participants and last one to four days, depending on content and your particular needs.

Depending on the workshop, participants may be introduced to structured analytic techniques that offer rigorous ways to perform important cognitive tasks such as:

- uncover all possible hypotheses or potential solutions to a problem
- marshal all arguments for and against before making a judgment
- scrutinise reasoning in detail, bringing out important assumptions
- evaluate information against different hypotheses simultaneously, avoiding premature commitment to one viewpoint
- evaluate different options against set criteria
- consider far-reaching consequences of prospective actions or events
- understand how situations come about and identify key features, including possible points of intervention
- find effective solutions to problems involving stakeholders with conflicting viewpoints
- break stalemates by identifying what information can resolve a disputed issue.
